- Parent/Son Camporee is open to all registered Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts (Wolf and Bear), and Webelos.
- This is not family camping. This event is for registered Cub Scouts, Parents, and Leaders only.
- Parking you cannot park in the campsites but can drive up to unload. However, you must move your car to one of
 the camp parking lots after you have unloaded your gear. We must keep the camp roads clear so we can get
 emergency vehicles into the campsites if needed.

What to bring for your Parent/Son adventure:

• Food: Pack 934 has elected the Meal Plan option. As such, the following applies:

Friday dinner and Saturday breakfast is on your own in your campsite. Some of the dens are cooking onsite for their outdoor cooking loop work during the camporee. The Bear and Webelo I dens are cooking Friday night and some are considering cooking Saturday night as well.

The following meals will be in the Dining Hall: Saturday Lunch; Saturday Dinner; Sunday Breakfast and are as follows:

Saturday Lunch: Turkey/Ham/Cheese Sub, Chips, Cookie, Tea, Water

<u>Saturday Dinner:</u> Chicken Pie, Mash Potatoes, Green Beans, Yeast Roll, Dessert, Tea, Water, Coffee Sunday Breakfast: Sausage Biscuit, and Danish, Milk or Juice

S'mores and marshmallows are always a hit at the Pack campfire. The Pack will provide them for both Friday and Saturday night.

We recommend bringing reusable water bottles and reusable insulated cups for hot drinks in the morning.

Trail mix is great for a snack in between meals and fits easily in your pockets or in a small backpack. Pack snacks in airtight containers and be sure to bring plenty of water. *Please store food in your car at night and when possible as to not attract wildlife* We can reserve refrigerator space at the dining hall. Please let Shannon know if you need refrigerator space.

• <u>Clothing and other notes:</u> Watch the weather and bring appropriate clothes for the temperature and rain gear, as the nights can be chilly and the days rainy at Camp Raven Knob.

Wear comfortable closed toed shoes. Also, you can bring hiking boots (sneakers are okay to hike in as well) as hiking opportunities are usually included as part of the activities. Reminder: Always go hiking with buddies and children never go without an adult.
